HIS THEOPHANIES	Pre-incarnate appearances of Jesus Christ, most often as " <i>The Angel</i> (Messenger) of the Lord" who receives the worship due to God alone.	Gen. 16:7-13, 18:1, 22:11-12, 31:11-13 & 32, 32:24-32, 48:15-16; Ex. 3:2, 5-6 & 14; Josh. 5:13-6:2; Judg. 13
THE INCARNATION AND HUMILIATION	Wherein Christ emptied Himself by laying aside His rights as the Son of God, took on human nature, and voluntarily submitted to the will of the Father unto death.	Philippians 2:5-8, 1 John 4:2-3 (cf. Jn. 1:14)
HIS DEATH AND RESURRECTION	Jesus Christ suffered a <u>real</u> death, rose <u>physically</u> from the grave having conquered sin and death and, as our representative, inhabits a <u>real</u> , glorified resurrection body forever.	Lk. 24:28-48; Jn. 20:24-27; Acts 2:22-36; 1 Cor. 15:3-8, 20-26; 2 Tim. 2:8; Phil. 3:20-21; 1 Jn. 3:2; Zech. 12:10; Rev. 1:7
HIS ASCENSION	Christ's victory over Satan, sin, and death accomplished, He ascended through the realm of the Prince of the Power of the Air to take His seat at the Father's right hand to act as our high priest and forerunner.	Lk. 24:50-51, Acts 1:9-11; Eph. 1:19-23; Col. 3:1-3; Heb. 6:19-20
HIS OFFICES	1. Prophet 2. Priest 3. King	Hebrews 1:1-2 Hebrews 4:14, 5:5-10, 8:1-2 Matthew 1:1-17, 21:1-5; Mk. 15:32; Lk. 1:32-33
